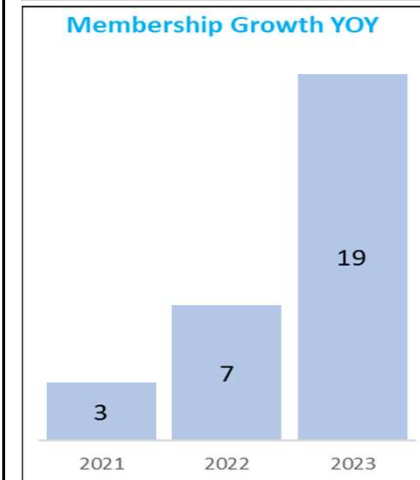
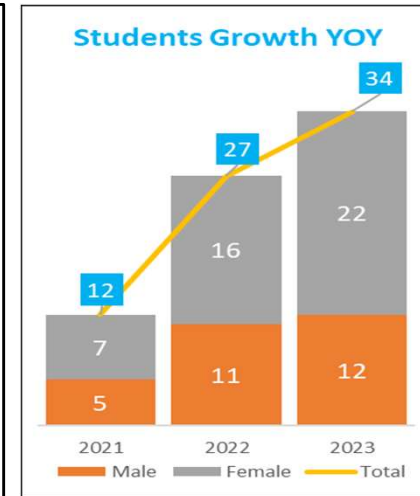

2023 Highlights

- Extended education support to 34 needy students located in various states of India (Delhi, West Bengal, Orissa, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand, Uttar Pradesh, Bihar). Out of 34 students 22 (65%) are girls.
- Nine students made significant progress.
- 3rd Mangrove Plantation Drive on 30th Dec'23.
- Organized 3rd Free Medical Test Camp for 170 adults on 29th Dec'23 with CSR funding from a Private Organization.
- Distributed ~160 blankets to underprivileged during winter.
- Initiated FCRA Registration process.
- Membership drive resulted in increase in life members from 7 to 19.
- Cancer awareness drive using Breast Examination Simulator

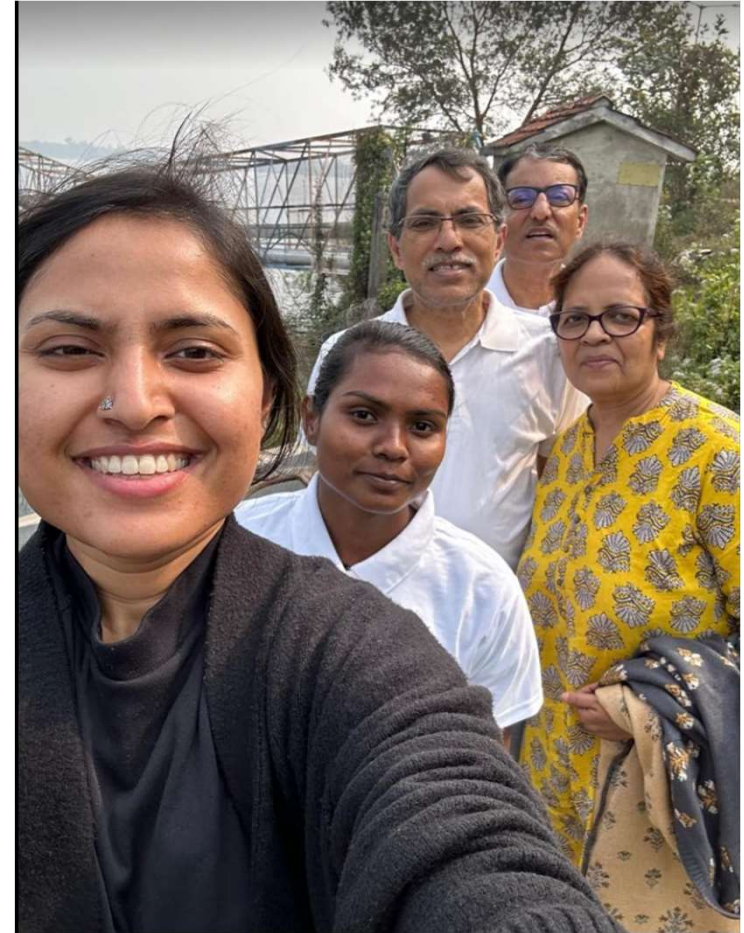

- Supported student must demonstrate strong determination to continue studies by maintaining their class results / grade

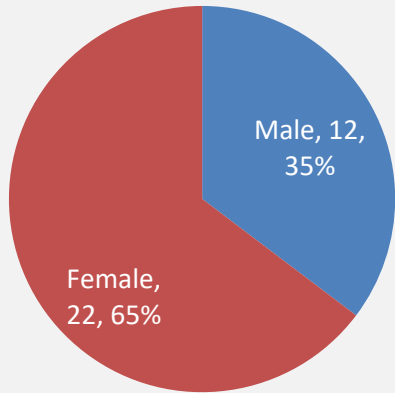

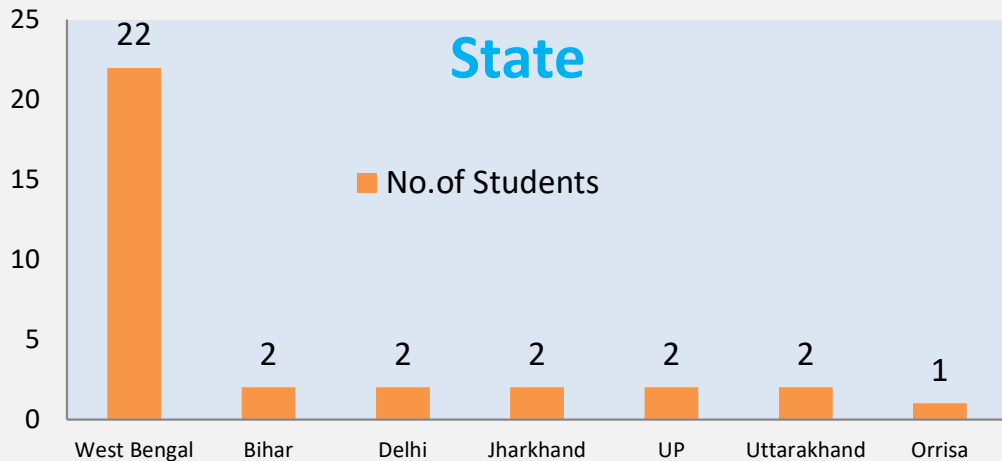
